In order to study some university-level courses, students are required to have completed certain high school classes. For example:

- To study university-level biology, chemistry or physics, the Grade 12 (senior-level) course of the same subject is required.
- To study university-level calculus, Grade 12 (senior-level) pre-calculus or a university-level pre-calculus class is required.

## Saskatchewan transcripts

Saskatchewan high school students must request transcripts to be shared directly to the University of Saskatchewan by the Ministry of Education.

IMPORTANT: Share your transcript directly with the University of Saskatchewan through the MyCreds portal, not by email. When you select the University of Saskatchewan from the list of registered organizations, USask will receive a notification that your transcript has been shared and will be notified automatically when there are updates. Leave the expiry date blank to ensure USask has access to your transcript throughout the admissions process. If you set an expiry date and it passes before USask can access your transcript to consider your application for admission or applications for scholarships, you will need to share it again and may incur an additional cost from MyCreds. Final grades for all subjects are needed to ensure admission conditions are met. If not received by August 1, it may impact students' admission and ability to enroll.
