### FLEXIBILITY

Starting your degree closer to home is a great way to ease your transition to university. As a University of Saskatchewan (USask) student living in your home community, you can enjoy more flexibility in balancing your studies with work and family life.

In person classes are offered at the St. Peter's College campus. Students can also register in USask online class options.

### FOCUSED SUPPORT
